The Carlton County Board of Commissioners met this 27th day of July, 2015, as the governing body of the Unorganized Townships of Clear Creek, Corona, Progress, Red Clover and Sawyer. The meeting was held at the Carlton County Transportation Building Meeting Room.

Chairperson Bodie called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Members present: Bodie, Brenner, Peterson, Proulx, and Zmyslony. Absent: None. Also in attendance were Rick Norrgard and Randy McCuskey of the Transportation Department.

Auditor/Treasurer Gassert reported on the proposed 2016 levies for fire protection, and ambulance services. Gassert also relayed that due to the legislature not passing a tax bill in 2015, no action was taken on the request to allow for a Recreational Levy for Sawyer Township. This request will be pursued in the 2016 legislative session. McCuskey and Norrgard reported on the various work done and to be done on UT roads.

Commissioner Peterson reported that the Cromwell and Wright Fire Departments are working towards the creation of a fire district.

No correspondence was received from interested parties regarding the unorganized townships. All matters related to the budgets and levies of the unorganized township will be referred to the County Board for consideration.
