

Recycling Grocery Bags & Other Plastic Film

Plastic film can't be recycled at county recycling centers or the Transfer Station, but it can be recycled at certain stores.

Plastic film collection bins are located at these stores:

- Super One Foods, Walmart, Cub Foods, and Whole Foods Co-Op
- Other stores may also have collection locations. If you shop at a store often, ask if they have a collection bin for plastic film.

Along with plastic shopping bags, the below items can also be included in the plastic film bin:

- **Newspaper bags**
- **Dry cleaning bags**
- **Bread bags**
- **Produce bags**
- **Toilet paper, napkin, and paper towel wraps**
- **Furniture wrap**
- **Electronic wrap**
- **Plastic retail bags (hard plastic and string handles removed)**
- **Grocery bags**
- **Plastic food storage bags (clean and dry) – (e.g. Ziploc® Bags)**
- **Plastic cereal box liners (if it tears like paper, do not include)**
- **Tyvek(no glue, labels, other material)**
- **Diaper wrap (packaging)**
- **Plastic shipping envelopes, bubble wrap, and air pillows (deflate/remove labels if possible)**
- **Case wrap (e.g., snacks, water bottles)**



Any other plastic film item that is clear, clean, and can be stretched with your thumb can be put into the plastic bag recycling bin.
